One Hour: \$40.00- A great trail for all riders, wonderful views of the Hermosa Cliffs and Missionary Ridge, terrain and plant life is so diversified on this short ride! Kids must be six years old

Two Hour: \$70.00- The trails go on winding in the 8200 ft elevation, some creek crossing and even more variety within the Ponderosa forests! Kids must be 8 years old.

Cave Ride: \$75.00 - Two hour excursions with a short hike and exploration of a natural water cave, this is a great family excursion for those with a sense of adventure!) Kids must be 6 years old

Three Hour ride: \$95.00 - One big loop or combine it with the cave! Kids must be 8 years old.

****Engineer Mountain ride: \$200.00 -**Voted one of top ten best rides in the USA by USA Today 2010. This is a ride we do only mid July through September. The elevations are 11,000 feet, and on up to almost 12,000. This ride is at timberline and the expanse of the high country tundra is truly one of the most amazing places to experience on horseback! Kids must be 14 years old.**
